### REFLECTIONS: 'In the quiet, I have stilled my soul like a child at rest...'

These words are important words in my journey. They are from Psalm 131, verse 2, and are particularly impacting for me as sung by John Michael Talbot on his album 'Come to the Quiet.' I like his music and when he visited Lamb of God some years ago we had him minister in two large Pentecostal Auditoriums, and both were packed. I recall John and his team needed access to the Christchurch auditorium for checking acoustics and sound a day before the concert. Philip and I were way towards the back near the entrances and John 'somewhere over there in the darkness of the stage'. The auditorium was in near darkness and then suddenly this gifted guitar playing and voice rang forth 'You are my Hiding Place Oh Lord...' Awesome indeed.



This past month has been particularly busy with a flight back from Fiji then six visits to other branches, plus six international guests with us for a range of days from eleven to sixteen. Plus the ever-draining 'no progress' on our personal earthquake related claims, nor any progress with the Lamb of God Centre claims.

In and following such busy times, I find a restoration of focus, peace and 'balance' with God essential for me. And generally I find this in three ways. The first is to seek the quiet of an empty church, or to attend a church service that is not intent on filling every moment with busyness but rather gives plenty of quiet time for reflecting and 'soaking in'. The second is to find a place of isolation in nature, and for me that generally means up into the mountains and enjoying working out on a reasonable climb on a ridge, or up a valley and into a snowfield. But I also enjoy just sitting in silence in the early morning, be it near a beach, under a tree in the garden, or near a river, and watching birds and wildlife start their busy days. In all such circumstances I find those special moments where *'In the quiet, I have stilled my soul like a child at rest...'*

Evangelising with vigour and vim!


God has blessed John with song-writing talent

## CHALLENGES IN LIVING TOGETHER AS COMMUNITY

Resource for House Group Discussion by Tom Caballes  
When the Well Runs Dry  
October 2013

*As a deer pants for flowing streams, so pants my soul for you, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God? My tears have been my food day and night, while they say to me all the day long, "Where is your God?" [Psalms 42:1-3]*

There are times when we follow God when we experience 'desolation' – when it seems God is so far away when we need Him most. It can come in the form of an unanswered prayer/s; or desires of our hearts that God seems to be deaf; or extreme waiting, longing or difficult situation. We can ask: *after I have given my all to follow God, is this what I get?* Sometimes these experiences challenges our faith in God and can cast doubt on His love and faithfulness. This is like when our spiritual wells run dry – and there is nothing left to sustain us. This is a path many saints have trodden – and sometimes He asks us to walk in this way.

### **So What Do We Do When "The Well Runs Dry?"**

1. Acknowledge your feelings before God. But look at the situation as an opportunity to grow. Know that you are in a trial. See **James 1:2-4** and **James 1:12**.
2. Have a balanced picture. Look in the past when you experienced God's love and faithfulness, when He was there when you need Him. Recall these times.
3. It is good to look back at the commitments that you made and do not turn away from them during these times. Continue to pray and read the Bible even if you do not get anything out of them. Continue to relate with and serve our brothers and sisters in community. These things keep our focus on others and let us avoid introspection. Have a balance of knowing our pains but also not dwelling too much on them.
4. All trials and difficulties are there for a time; know that in time, they will pass. We need to learn to endure and last it out. Know that our enemy wants us to give up. Guess who succeeds when we give in to doubt, or abandon God completely?
5. Talk with a person who can help you with during these difficult times. The more we discuss it with a wiser person, the more help we can get – and *"the prayer of a good man is full of power in its working"* **James 5:16b**.

### **Other Scripture References**

1. *And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.* **[Romans 8:28]**
2. *For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.* **[Romans 8:18]**
3. *For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison...* **[2 Corinthians 4:17]**
4. Other references: **1 Peter 1:6-9; Romans 8:31-39; Proverbs 27:9.**

### **For Personal Reflection and Group Sharing:**

1. When I experience dryness in my spiritual life, do I hang on or do I let doubt creep in my life? Do I give in to self-pity?
2. *Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?* **[Romans 8:35]**

## **PRAYERWATCH - SOLDIERS OF CHRIST, ARISE**

*Reinforce the guard, station the watchmen, prepare an ambush! The Lord will carry out his purpose... Jeremiah 51: 12 NIV*

Reading the prophetic word from our gatherings is important as we need to watch for trends, especially as it relates to the Prayerwatch. As I add any relevant words to the weekly updates, any trends concerning spiritual warfare show up quickly. Last year 27 words were used as part of the weekly update. This year up till the end of May there were 14 words used, with another 13 used in June, July and August. Following are another 13 words with reference to God protecting the Lamb of God community and its people. This adds up to a total of 40 words for the year, well ahead of last year encouraging us in spiritual warfare and we are being protected by God our Father. The prophetic word also tells us that God is calling us, we are called to righteousness, to persevere and to proclaim God word among other themes. Following are some of the words with the extracts concerning spiritual warfare and God protecting us.

South Island Meeting – June 29, 2013: *The Lord is reminding us that we are in a spiritual battle; The Lord and His angels are with us, but Satan will bring the battle before us; we are not to underestimate Satan and his power. The Lord will fight this battle for us and the Lord has power overall.*

Wellington Prophetic Word 28 July 2013: *He wants us to have that discerning spirit by focusing on His words so that we will not be confuse as we are living in the dark ages of the world and the enemy is just around us and will attack us when we are confuse.*

East Auckland Prophetic Word 28 July 2013: *1 Peter 5: 8 Be sober, be watchful, your adversary – the devil prowls around like a roaring lion seeking someone to devour.”*

Christchurch Prophecy 4/8/13: *“Ephesians 6: 10-18 Put on all of God’s armour so that you will be able to stand safe against all strategies and tricks of Satan.*

East Auckland Prophetic Word 11 AUGUST 2013: *I had this picture of a storm raging round a child, but the child is not perturbed because he is in the hands of a loving Father who is covering him and shielding him from all that is going on around him.*

Christchurch Prophecy 8/9/13: *“Psalm 62: He alone protects and saves me. He is my defender and I shall never be defeated.*

Wellington Prophetic Word 08 September 2013: *His promise is that He is holding the community in His hands and protecting each and every one of us.*
